
God's Solution to our Limiting Assumptions: Childlike Faith

Unstuck Breaking Free From The Cage of Assumptions

The Cage of Assumption: We think of God in Human Terms

2 Symptoms:

- We lose sight of the miraculous
- We live a <u>pick and choose</u> faith

How do we break free from the cage of assumptions?

- 1. Accept the truth that God is beyond my understanding
- **Job 36: 26 (ESV)** Behold, God is great, and we know him not; the number of his years is unsearchable.
- **Ecclesiastes 3:11 (NIV)** He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart; yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end.
- **Psalm 92:5-6 (ESV)** ⁵ How great are your works, O LORD! Your thoughts are very deep! ⁶ The stupid man cannot know; the fool cannot understand this:
- **Romans 11:33 (NIV)** ³³ Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable his judgments, and his paths beyond tracing out!
- Our <u>Assumptions</u> about God do not limit God, they limit our <u>ability</u>
 to experince God for who he really is.

2. Identify my Assumptions about God

Common Assumptions about God:

God does not exist

- **1 Corinthians 8:4** "If anyone imagines that he knows something, he does not yet know as he ought to know."
- Acknowledge I don't know everything

God has forgotten me

- o Psalm 13:1-6, Isaiah 49:12, Psalm 38:17-18
- o Trust in God's Steadfast love, don't stop praying

$God\ does\ not\ care\ about\ \underline{my\ actions}$

- Galatians 6:7-10
- o Don't be deceived I will reap what I sow

3. A Shift in <u>Perspective</u>: My Limitations vs. God's Limitless Abilities

Genesis 15:1-6 (ESV) After these things the word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision: "Fear not, Abram, I am your shield; your reward shall be very great." ² But Abram said, "O Lord Godd, what will you give me, for I continue childless, and the heir of my house is Eliezer of Damascus?" ³ And Abram said, "Behold, you have given me no offspring, and a member of my household will be my heir." ⁴ And behold, the word of the LORD came to him: "This man shall not be your heir; your very own son shall be your heir." ⁵ And he brought him outside and said, "Look toward heaven, and number the stars, if you are able to number them." Then he said to him, "So shall your offspring be." ⁶ And he believed the LORD, and he counted it to him as righteousness.
